### The Plan going forward and the season ahead...!

Now we have had a few weeks of getting back into the swing of hockey and brushing away the rust from the summer months, we can now concentrate on honing our skills and have listened to the feedback of the children, you the parents and the coaching teams. Therefore we are proactively putting together a fixture list and have been active in our pursuit to ensure that the children will get to play competitive hockey against other clubs in the area. Therefore we have acquired the 12noon until 2pm slot at Thames Ditton which runs after the older group session to invite opposing teams down to play friendly matches. We have also been working hard to secure competitive fixtures and will be taking all age groups away to clubs in the area to play mini tournaments against other teams in the same age group.

This all culminates in Surrey County Tournaments in March of next year where all clubs in the county come together to compete to represent Surrey in the National Championships for the U10's & U12's. We are a long way off this and as the existing members remember from last year in our first tournament was a bit of a baptism of fire. However we have taken lots of positives from our experiences and are planning forward to ensure that we can compete against the more established colts sections in the area by working toward this in many different areas.

Therefore we are asking parents to help with our planning and logistics as we take teams away for fixtures and we need your support as fixtures are planned through the season, both at home and away for all age groups from U8's, through the U10's and to the U.12's. Also from time to time we will be moving some of the slots around on a Sunday morning to accommodate the games, so please keen reading the newsletters and look out for the fixture list to ensure you are not caught out...!!
